END OF SPECIAL ADMINISTRATION

On 10 January 2020, a delegate of the Registrar of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Corporations (**the Registrar**) made a determination under division 487 of the *Corporations (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) Act 2006 (CATSI Act)* that the Buurabalayji Thalanyji Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC (ICN 7105) (**the corporation**) would be under special administration from 12:01am (AWST) on Monday, 13 January 2020 until 11:59pm (AWST) on Friday, 17 July. On 17 July 2020, the special administration was extended until 11:59pm (AWST) on Friday, 16 October 2020.

I write to confirm the special administration will end at 11:59 pm (AWST) on Friday, 16 October 2020 and after this time the control of the corporation's affairs will rest with the directors who have been appointed by the special administrator using his powers under section 499-5(3)(d) of the CATSI Act.

The directors have been appointed until the 2022 AGM.

I understand that the special administrator will provide a handover report to the corporation in relation to the various matters dealt with during the period of the special administration and information about the corporation's current operating environment and matters still needing attention of the directors.

The Registrar will be monitoring the corporation closely over the next 12 months to ensure it properly transitions back to normal operations. A determination made under section 336-1 of the CATSI Act, which sets out in detail the reports and information that is required, will be issued to the corporation shortly.

I ask that the directors carry out their functions and exercise their powers with full care and diligence and in the best interests of the corporation.
